#### Submit Your Final Transcripts

International students should submit copies in English and the original language of instruction as well as any applicable graduation certificates or leaving exam results. Drexel University reserves the right to withdraw your offer of admission in the event that 1) you show a significant drop in academic performance, 2) you fail to graduate, or 3) you misrepresent yourself in the application process.

#### Notify Drexel of Disciplinary Actions

You are required to notify Drexel of any legal or disciplinary actions taken against you prior to enrollment. Drexel University reserves the right to withdraw your offer of admission in the event that the University learns that you have engaged in behavior indicating a serious lack of judgment or integrity prior to your enrollment.

### NEXT STEPS

Now that you have been admitted, there are some additional items you must complete before officially becoming a student at Drexel University.

### Housing Deposit

You must submit a \$200 nonrefundable housing deposit along with your \$300 tuition deposit.

### International Students Visa Sponsorship

Students without United States citizenship or permanent residence (also called a green card) will require a visa that permits them to study in the United States. Academic programs with a co-op component also require that the student's status permits them to work in the United States.

Drexel can support you in pursuing one of two types of student visas: an F-1 visa or a J-1 visa.
