The College Board has been partnering with [Schoolhouse.world](#), a nonprofit tutoring platform started by Sal Khan (the founder of Khan Academy®), to research the impact of a free, online SAT® tutoring program run by volunteer peer tutors. Over the past year, the program has helped more than 12,000 students effectively prepare to tackle the SAT.

We're inviting your teen, based on their previous SAT score, to participate in this study as a peer tutor in the upcoming SAT bootcamp, taking place between April 7 and May 4 in preparation for the May SAT.

By becoming a volunteer peer tutor in this online SAT tutoring pilot, Shanelle [REDACTED] will tutor about 10 students over the course of four weeks. Peer tutors benefit in several ways. Past SAT tutors reported that they:
